Questions 37 to 40 are based on the following talk.

Crocodiles and alligators, these are the two dangerous creatures that are indistinguishable to normal people, but they can't be more different in the eye of an expert. Here are some tips to help you tell them apart. First, they prefer different habitats. While crocodiles are found mainly in salty water, alligators are less tolerant to salt and live in freshwater like the river or the lake. Their snouts, the characteristic feature of both creatures, are also shaped differently. A crocodile has a more pointed, V-shaped snout, while the alligator's is wider and U-shaped. In fact, the difference gives the alligator a stronger biting force than the crocodiles. It is notable that when the snouts are shut, all of the crocodiles' teeth are shown, while the alligators' teeth are partially hidden. There are other physical differences. A crocodile can grow up to 6.5 meters and 1,000 kilograms, while it's 4.5 meters and 450 kilograms for an alligator. As for their characters, keep in mind that crocodiles are more aggressive and dangerous; on the other hand. alligators are less likely to chase you down. Even so, you must keep off both of the creatures. They are fast swimmers, but they are also fast runners on land.
